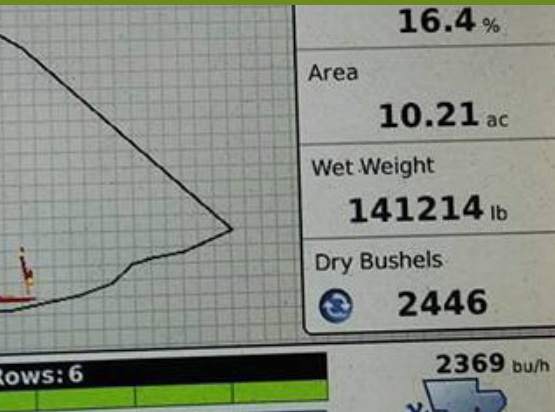


JOIN US FOR TECH TUESDAY
